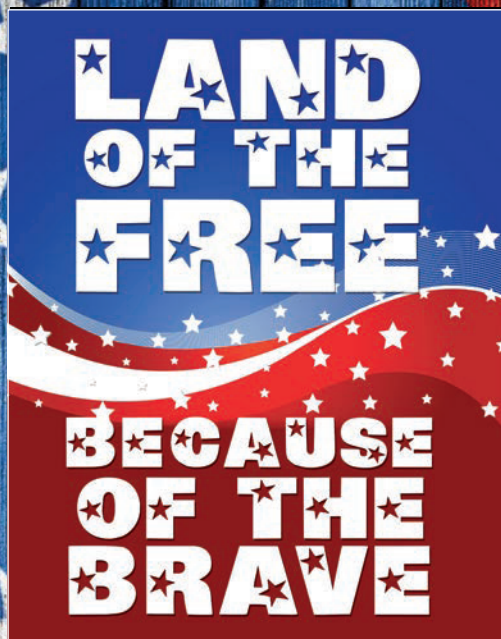


A Most Respectful Shout Out To Veterans
